














Founded in February 1990, the CAAC, Centro Andaluz de Arte Contemporáneo is an institution dedicated to the research, conservation, promotion, and diffusion of contemporary art, as well as to the creation and conservation of a permanent collection.

In 1997, the former Monastery of La Cartuja became its headquarters, which also led to the incorporation of the Monumental Complex of La Cartuja and the Museum of Contemporary Art of Seville, including their respective collections.

Later, in 2018, two new spaces were added: the C3A Centro de Creación Contemporánea de Andalucía, located in the city of Córdoba, and the 15th Century Pavilion within the grounds of the former Cartuja, currently under renovation to be mainly used as a reserve area and exhibition space for the collection.

Since its inception, the CAAC has developed an extensive program of activities with a clear focus on research and diffusion, aiming to promote the study and encouragement of contemporary artistic creation, at the Andalusian, national, and international levels through temporary exhibitions, educational programs, courses, workshops, concerts, film series, conferences, and more.
